In this blueprint, you'll learn how to use both the FREE and Proversions of this template, and how this template might fit into your workflow. The next few pages include some sample input and output for the template. Be very careful with your input. Study the following examples and analyze them carefully. Why? So you can achieve better results. In more than 95% of cases, people who get poor output after 3 generations had poor input. That's why it's critical to fully understand what type of input a template expects before you start using it. Join the Frase Facebook group if you have questions or are struggling.

# INSTRUCTIONS AND WORKFLOW SUGGESTIONS

The Frase AI template "Blog H2 Generator (standard)" is designed to create a list of possible subtopics (such as H2 subtopics) that you could discuss in your article about a specific main topic (such as your H1).

What's the use case? It depends. When writing a blog post on a keyword that is very competitive, I usually start by searching for commonalities between the subheadings (H2) in the top 20 search results on Google. When I find a bunch of common subheadings, I'll include them in my article. Then I might use this template to insert additional subheadings that the SERP hasn't included (but are contextually relevant).

In contrast, if you write a blog post about a keyword that is not competitive, most of Google's top 20 results won't be relevant to your blog post. In that case, what subheadings should you include in your article? Use your brain and research abilities as a starting point. Once you've exhausted all your ideas, try this template. It might surprise you and generate some interesting discussion topics.

Writing a 5,000-word blog post isn't the goal. The goal should be to cover the topic exhaustively so that your article can rank number one on Google.

TLDR: Use headings from relevant results in the SERP first, then use this template.
